#### **Enhanced Search Capabilities**

- Concept Search auto-expands search terms with system-generated synonyms.
- Faceted Search applies filters to search results, refining the product of the search.
- Match Rank sorts search results by order of relevancy to search terms and allows the reviewer begin with the most relevant documents first.
- The Expand Search Results command captures near-duplicates and/or email threads in the result, even if individual members of the set did not match the original search terms.

#### **Tagging Discrepancy Dashboard**

- Checks review sets for tagging discrepancies. Reviewer can jump directly from dashboard to document viewer and revise tagging as necessary.
- Makes QA quick and accurate, improves future search results, and lessens the chance of unwanted documents being produced.
