Discussion will focus on remote data collection, analysis of file data, Windows processes and dynamic-link libraries, registry data, network artifacts and threat detection, including the detection of rootkits. In addition, the course will demonstrate how to leverage AccessData Enterprise to achieve swift and thorough remediation. Lessons will be reinforced with practical exercises throughout the course.
